

Minutes Alford Board of Selectmen

October 22, 2018

Meeting called to order 7:05pm by Charles Ketchen, Chairman

Minutes of September 24 and October 10 approved.

Highway Department

Green reports that the "Slip Culvert" on North Egremont Road has started and will be finished by the end of the week. He hope to have the Line painter come before winter if they are in the area again.

The new compactor is in and will be delivered in the next two weeks or so. The Transfer station will have to be closed while the new compactor is being installed.

There will be an inspection of the Transfer Station area on October 23 by the DEP/CET

Town Counsel:

Richard Dahoney attended the meeting to get an update from the Select Board on how they would like to proceed with the dispute between Mr. Wacks and Butternut Tree Service. The Select Board will stand by their original agreement to take down the trees in question.

Historical District Commission:

Alice Halstead reported that over 300 meals were served at the square dance on September 1st. They would like to have another square dance next year.

The commission would like the Select Board to appoint an Ad Hoc group with representatives from the various boards in Alford to discuss and implement a plan for the former parsonage to become a town owned building and have it included in the Historic District. The Select Board will appoint a committee at the next meeting on November 1, 2018.

Ketchen made a motion to sign an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Town of Egremont so that AlfordLink could provide Fiber optic service to Egremont resident that border Alford. Second by Puciloski. Motion passed unanimously.

Board of Health Fees for disposal works permit will be increased to \$125 per plan effective immediately.
